Player & Parent Agreement

1. Remember, you are representatives of Dunes Volleyball Club and your community. Treat everyone as you would like to be treated.
2. Be a good teammate! Parents too!
 - a. Encourage the team and your teammates.
 - b. Work together and strive to work with all team members always. Your approach should not just be WHAT IS BEST FOR ME, but should be WHAT IS BEST FOR THE TEAM?
 - c. Be positive in attitude toward volleyball and emphasize the competitive nature of the sport.
3. Players are expected to make every practice and competition. While we realize there are times you might have conflicts, you must notify your coach ahead of time. Players are expected to make up those missed practices with another team at their competitive level.
 - a. Approach every practice as an opportunity to improve. It is vital that the atmosphere in the gym be one of concentration, intensity and enthusiasm.
4. **No use of illegal substances including tobacco, alcohol, and drugs.**
 - a. Any player who receives a reprimand or suspension from their school within the last year must speak with the club director before being allowed to return to participation.
5. Realize that playing time is earned and will not be equal among all players.
 - a. If there is a need to talk to the coach regarding this matter you may call the club director, at the appropriate time (not during competitions), to set up a meeting.
 - b. Coaches will not discuss other players' playing time.
 - c. We will not discuss playing time, team strategies, or any other issues until 24 hrs after the competition (including multiple day competitions.)
 - d. Any behavior from a player's parent, guardian, or relative that is abusive, disruptive, or detrimental to the team could result in removal of that player from the team. Parents need to set an example of being a good sport and being respectful. Your actions may create a reputation with your name and potentially ruin the experience for your child!
6. Keep your area clean and dispose of your garbage properly - the playing and practice sites should NOT be responsible for cleaning up after you!
7. Not addressing tournament officials, referees, spectator, other teams, etc. in a negative manner. Rules are constantly changing and even though you may think you know them, you probably do not. Coaches, not parents, oversee making sure the officials are making correct calls.
8. Arrive at practice and tournaments on time and ready to play.
9. Bring all uniforms, shirts, knee pads, and shoes to all tournaments.
10. Each player is expected to share equally in the officiating responsibilities. No player leaves if the team still has officiating duties unless given special permission from the coach and then only in special circumstances.
11. If you decide to withdraw your child from the team, you realize that you are still responsible for the cost of the entire season.

I will agree to abide by the rules as set forth in this athletic code. I realize that if these rules are not adhered to, the player may be asked to leave the team with no refund given.
